

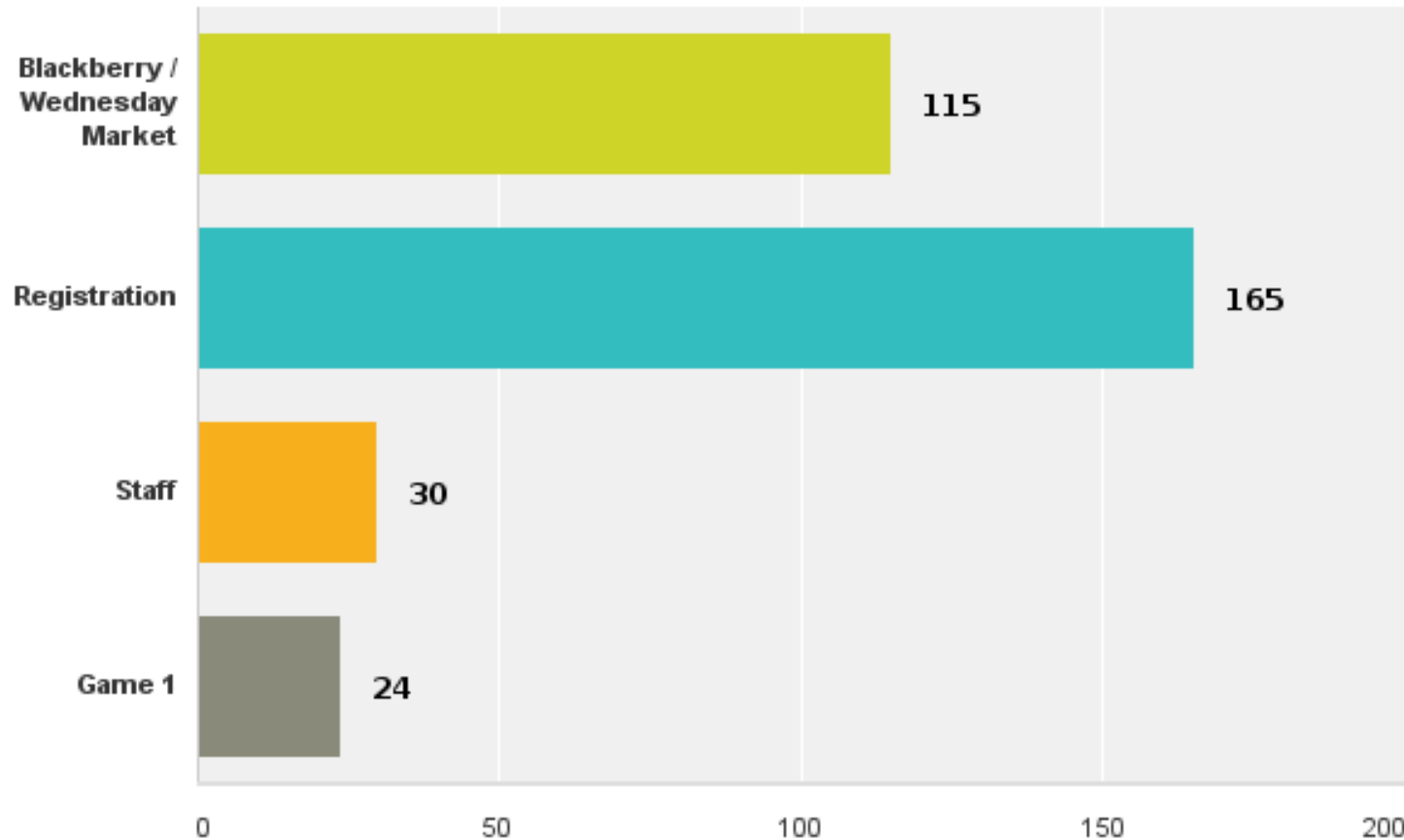

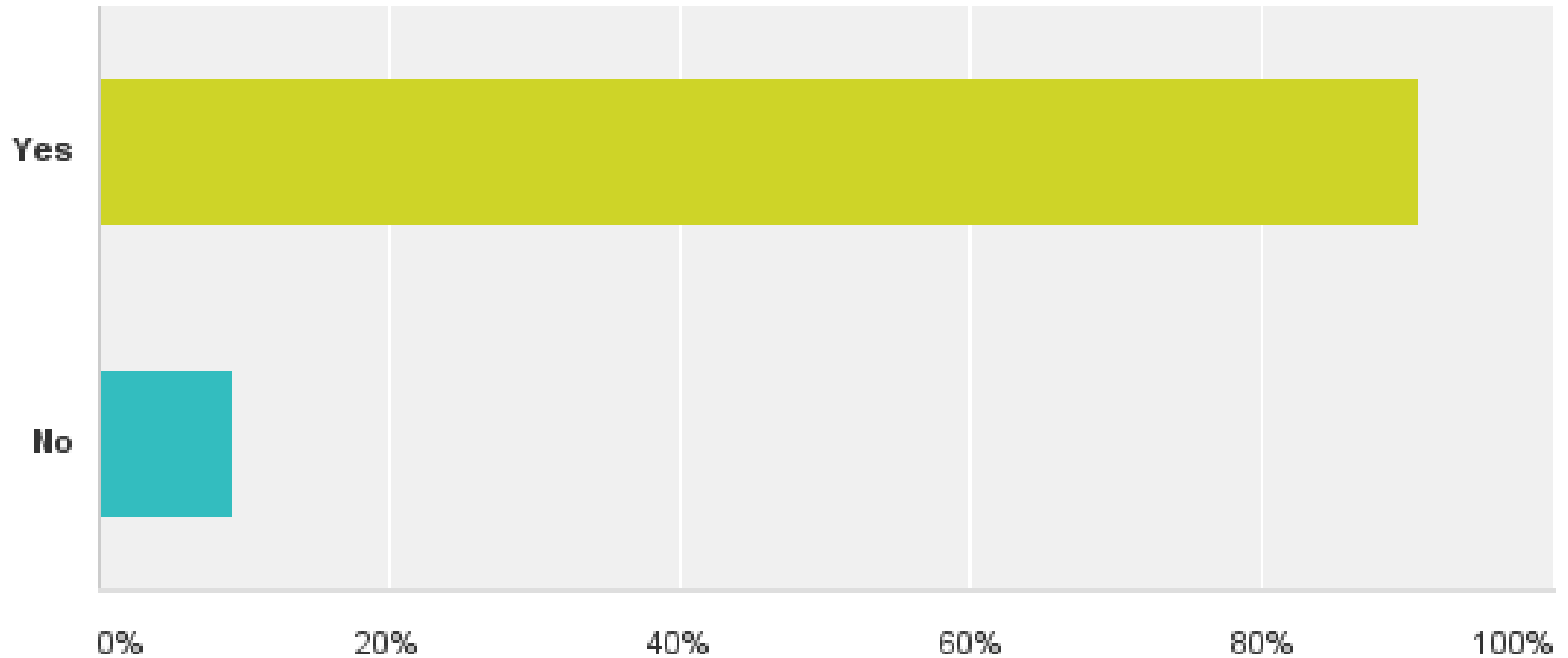

Where are you taking this survey?



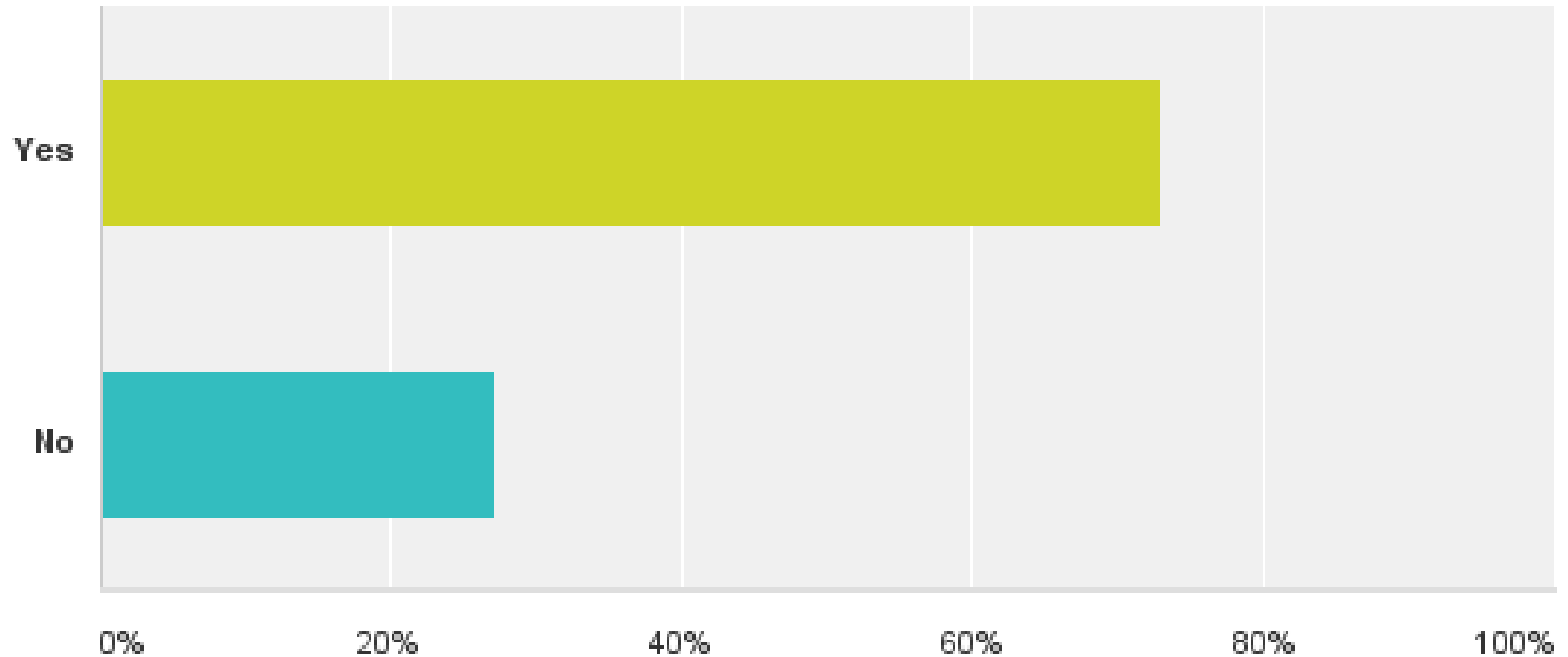
Do you feel good buildings are necessary for a good education?

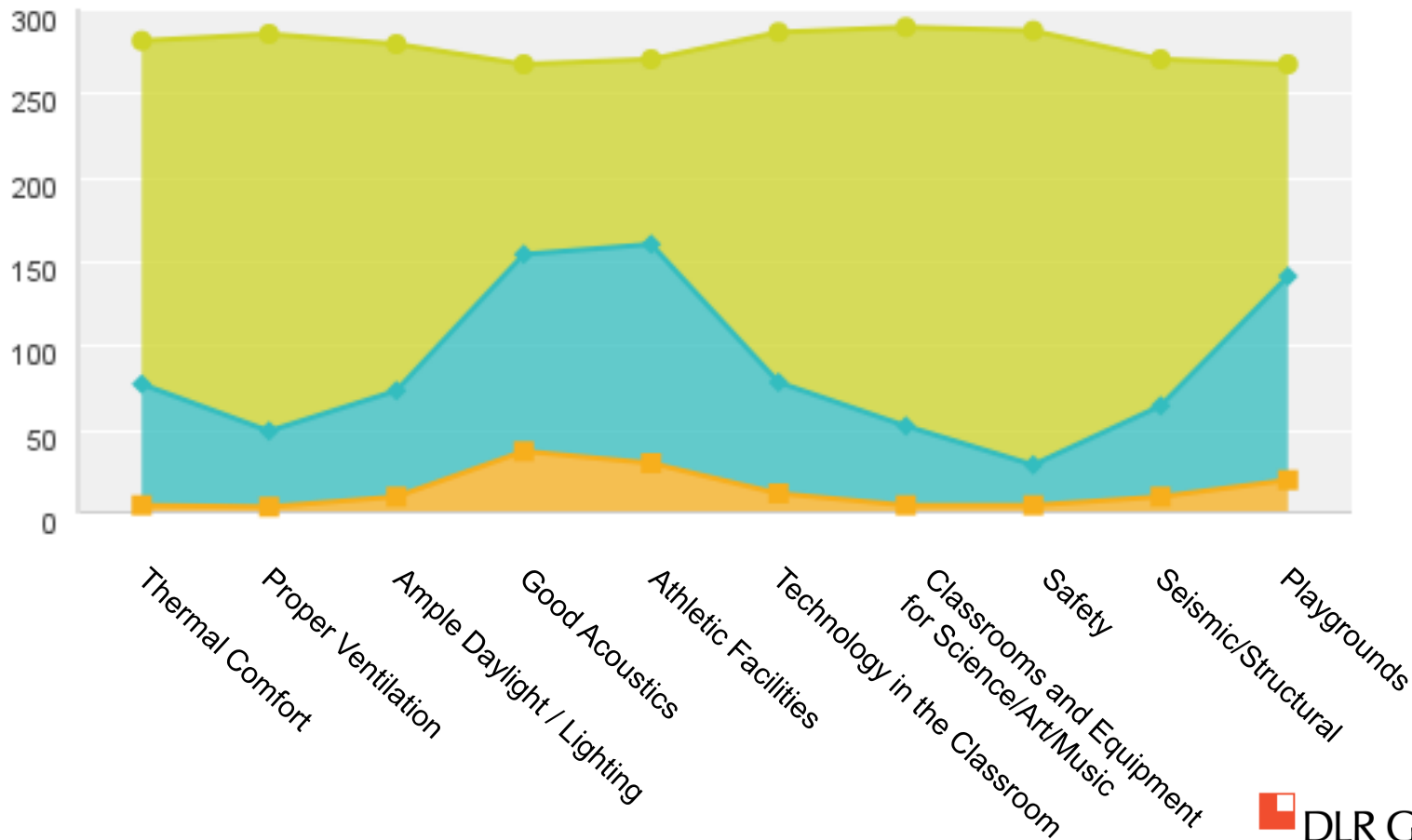

Coos Bay Schools are older and some do not have features that have been identified to improve student achievement. How would you rate the importance of each type of building improvement?

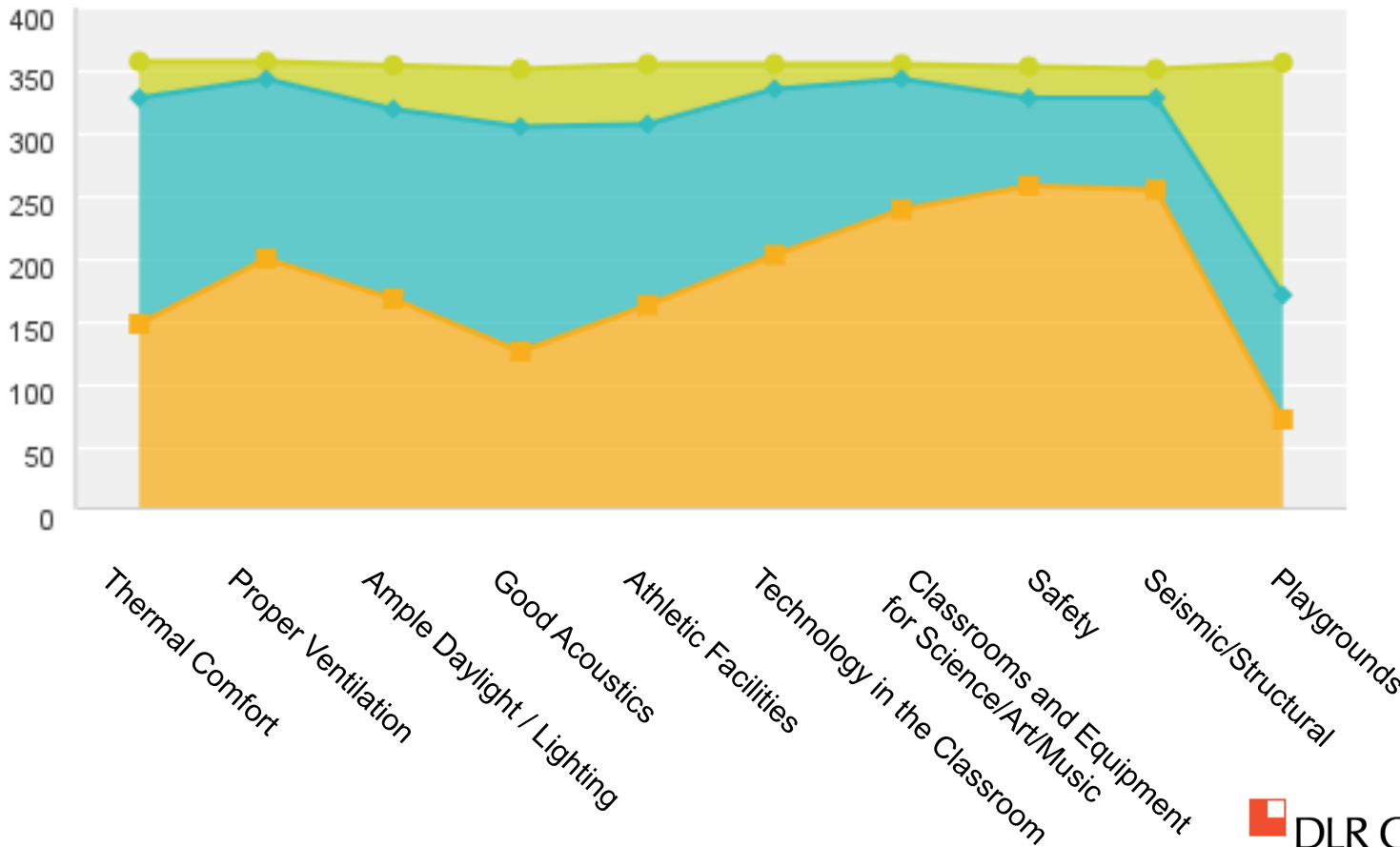

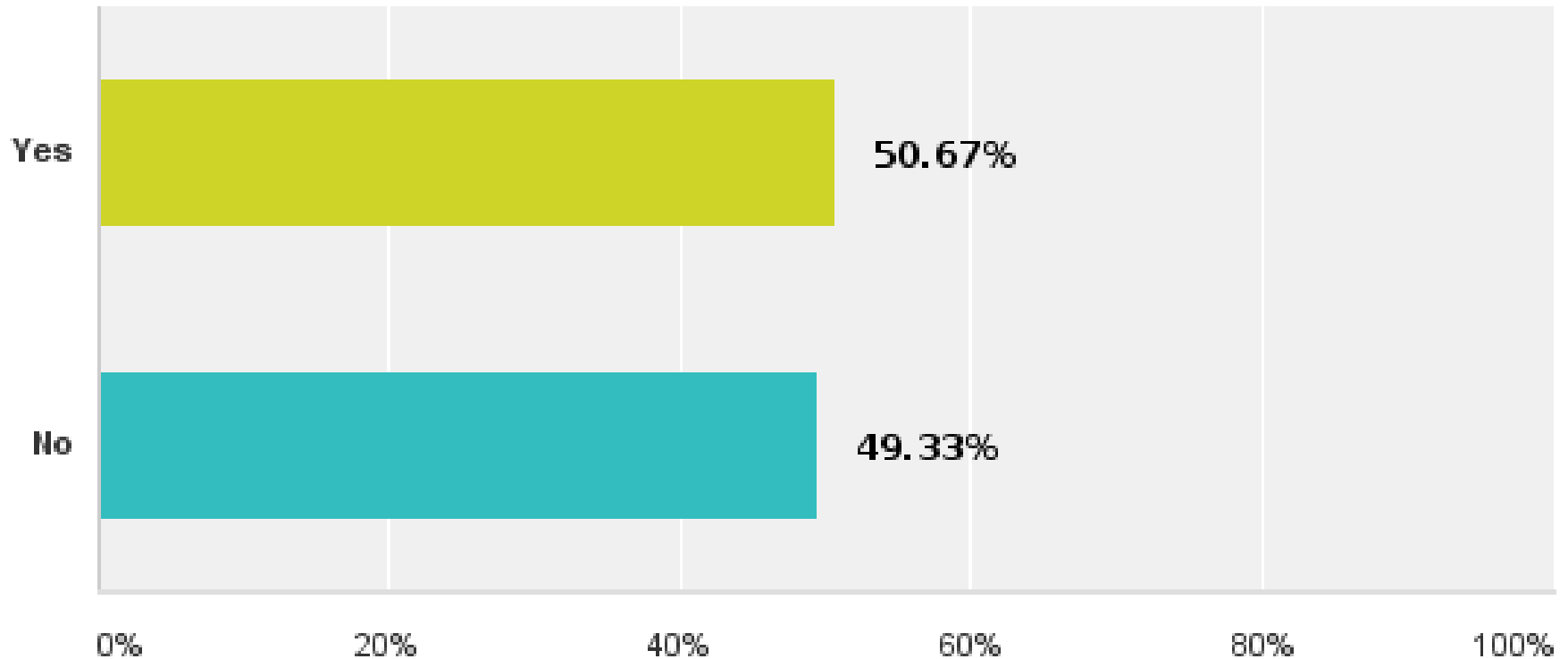

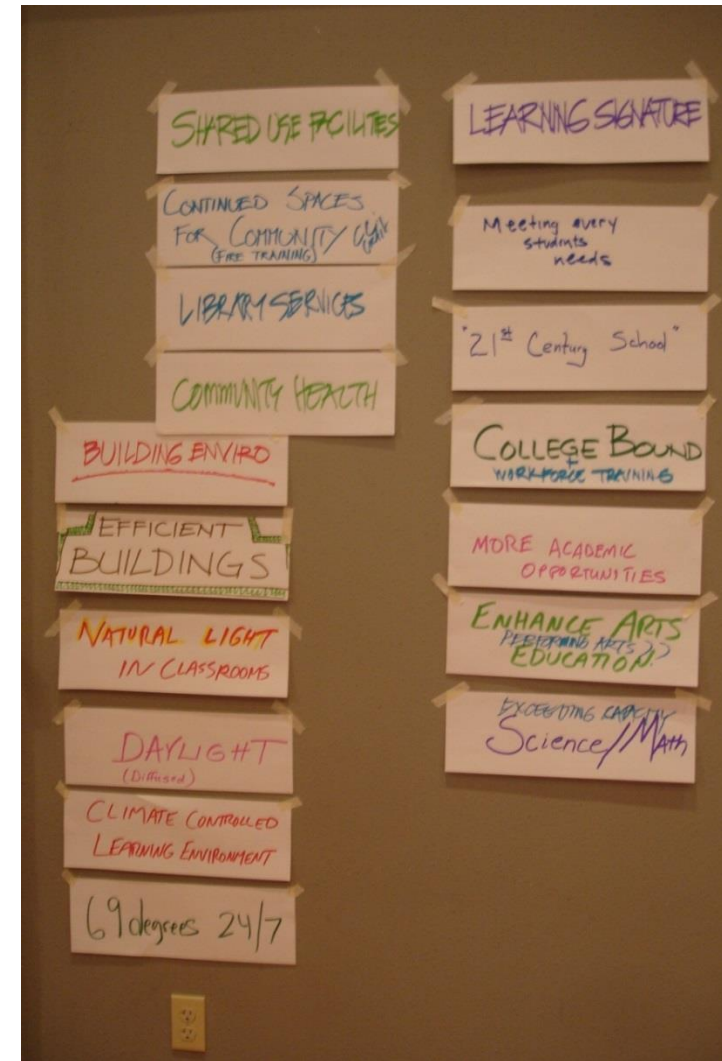
